

# Did Karan Johar & Farah Khan ignore Salman Khan's brother-in-law Aayush

**Mumbai, 7 June:** Filmmaker Karan Johar has taken a strong stand against a section of pod-casters. He believes these shows thrive on controversy and allow guests to make offensive comments about people in the film industry. In his note, the director also expressed disappointment with astrologers and psychics who sensationalise their appearances by making disturbing predictions about celebrities.

On Saturday, Karan Johar took to Instagram stories to call out what he described as a problematic "sub-culture" in the podcast space. Without taking names, he accused certain platforms of deliberately inviting irrelevant guests in order to attract attention through their controversial statements.

He wrote, "While I have utmost respect for credible and respectable members of the media! One sub-culture of podcasters (basically chat shows with new age terminology) who have emerged from the woodworks...



woods that no GPS can locate... they invite guests who have nothing to lose. Who haven't been invited since World War 2, and those guests spew venom and say the most disrespectful things about hardworking and legendary members of our fraternity!"

Taking his criticism further, Karan slammed shows that feature astrologers and psychics

making frightening predictions about actors. He remarked, "This needs to stop! Also, psychics and astrologers giving awful and scary revelations, even about people's impending death, is both insensitive and disgusting! Free speech? Yes. Clickbait for followers? No!"

Karan Johar's comments come at a time when podcasts have become increasingly influ-

ential in shaping public narratives about Bollywood. While some platforms foster healthy discussion, others have been accused of chasing views through provocative content.

On the professional front, he recently co-produced Dhadak 2, starring Triptii Dimri and Siddhant Chaturvedi. He will also appear in Aryan Khan's directorial debut The Ba\*\*\*ds of Bollywood, premiering on Netflix on September 18.

Filmmaker, producer, and storyteller Karan Johar is known for his cinematic flair and glamorous life, but behind it all, he also has struggles. In a podcast episode with Soul Safar with Bhaav, Karan Johar recently opened up about dealing with emotional problems and covering them with retail therapy.

The renowned director shared how he used shopping to cover up sadness and loneliness and how he came to realise that retail can't help him deal with his

problems. "I am trying to chase joy, which is definitely not coming from my success," Karan Johar shared.

Retail therapy is when you shop while feeling down or stressed, and make a purchase to boost your mood. According to the Cleveland Clinic, retail therapy is "the act of shopping with the goal of improving your mood or avoiding difficult emotions."

Superstar Rajinikanth's publicist Riaz Ahmed, late on Saturday night, quoting the tweet he had put out earlier, wrote, "Clarification Statement! Due to an earlier miscommunication, there was some confusion regarding the Coolie Meet & Greet Thalaivar contest by Malik Streams. We now confirm that the contest is valid, organised with the required details, and open for participation. We thank all fans for their understanding and unwavering support."

The confusion began on Saturday morning when Superstar Rajinikanth's publicist Riaz Ahmed put out a clarification that a 'Meet and Greet Thalaivar' contest that was being
