PM Modi Enjoys Jhalmuri Served by CM Suvendu Adhikari at NDA Meeting

Kolkata, 10 June : In an imagined scene that blends regional culture with political symbolism, Prime Minister Narendra Modi was warmly welcomed at an NDA meeting with one of Bengal's most beloved street delicacies—freshly prepared jhalmuri—personally served by West Bengal Chief Minister Suvendu Adhikari. The fictional moment quickly became the highlight of the gathering, with political observers describing it as an expression of humility, cultural pride, and the power of simple gestures in public life. As senior leaders assembled for strategic discussions, the atmosphere reportedly shifted from formal deliberations to light-hearted conversation when the Chief Minister arrived carrying traditional earthen bowls filled with spicy puffed rice mixed with mustard oil, roasted peanuts, green chilies, onions, coriander, and a blend of signature Bengali spices. Prime Minister Modi, known for his appreciation of regional cuisines during his travels across India, was imagined smiling as he accepted the snack and praised Bengal's rich culinary traditions. According to the fictional narrative, he remarked that India's unity is often reflected through its diverse local foods and cultural heritage. The gesture soon became a talking point among leaders attending the meeting. A bowl of jhalmuri served with warmth can become a reminder that India's strength lies not only in its institutions but also in its everyday traditions that connect millions of people. Whether viewed as a gesture of hospitality, a celebration of Bengal's culinary heritage, or a symbol of political goodwill, the fictional episode illustrates how ordinary cultural

expressions can acquire extraordinary significance in the public imagination. Though entirely fictional, the story paints a vivid picture of how a simple Bengali snack could become an enduring symbol of unity, mutual respect, and the shared cultural fabric that binds the world's largest democracy together. Improved connectivity, industrial investment, digital infrastructure, and logistics development could significantly enhance the state's competitiveness and attract domestic as well as international capital. The meeting also underscores the importance of dialogue in India's federal system. Even amid intense political rivalry, communication between central policymakers and regional leaders remains a key mechanism for addressing developmental priorities and administrative challenges. A Day After Chief Minister's Announcement, New Flex Boards Installed at Digha Temple Complex; Dham Replaced with Cultural Centre

Kolkata, 10 June : In a development that has drawn widespread public and political attention, newly installed flex boards appeared at the Digha temple premises just a day after the Chief Minister's announcement regarding the site's official identity. The updated signage prominently describes the location as a "Cultural Centre", while the previously used term "Dham" has reportedly been removed from the complex's public displays. The swift replacement of the signage has fueled discussions about the government's approach to branding and presenting the landmark, with many observers noting the speed at which the administrative changes were reflected on the ground. Visitors arriving at the temple complex noticed the newly erected flex banners carrying the revised terminology. The updated displays emphasize the site's role as a centre celebrating Bengal's cultural and spiritual heritage rather than identifying it with the religious designation that had earlier appeared on promotional materials. Officials associated with the project have indicated that the revised wording is intended to present the complex as a



broader cultural destination that welcomes people from diverse backgrounds while preserving its religious significance. According to this interpretation, the focus is on integrating art, history, architecture, and spirituality within a single cultural space. The removal of the word "Dham," however, has generated varied reactions among devotees, local residents, and political commentators. Some believe the change reflects an administrative clarification intended to avoid confusion over official nomenclature, while others see it as a symbolic shift in how the site will be promoted in the future. Social media platforms quickly filled with photographs comparing the earlier signage with the newly installed flex boards. The images sparked debates over whether the modification represents a simple

change in terminology or signals a broader policy regarding the management and branding of religious tourism projects in the state. Tourism experts suggest that positioning the complex as a cultural centre could potentially broaden its appeal, attracting visitors interested in heritage, architecture, and regional traditions alongside pilgrims. Such a strategy has been adopted at several historical destinations where governments seek to combine cultural tourism with religious significance. Political observers have also noted the timing of the change, coming immediately after the Chief Minister's public remarks. The rapid installation of the new signage has highlighted the administration's intent to ensure consistency between official statements and public-facing displays.

Two Senior Congress Leaders Rush to Delhi with Complaints Against Chief Minister D.K. Shivakumar

New Delhi, 10 June: The internal tensions within the Congress party over the leadership of Karnataka continue to intensify, with fresh signs that the long-simmering power struggle has yet to be resolved. In the latest development, two senior leaders from the state have reportedly traveled to New Delhi to present their grievances against Chief Minister D.K. Shivakumar before the party's central leadership, adding a new dimension to the ongoing political uncertainty. The move has reignited speculation over divisions within the Karnataka Congress, where competing factions have been at odds over governance, administrative decisions, and the balance of power inside the state government. While the party leadership has repeatedly maintained that the government remains united and stable, recent developments suggest that dissatisfaction among certain sections of the organization persists. According to political observers, the visit by the two leaders reflects

growing concerns within parts of the state unit regarding decision-making and leadership style. The delegation is believed to have sought an audience with senior members of the Congress high command to communicate their concerns and request intervention to address



internal differences before they escalate further. Sources familiar with the political developments indicate that the complaints reportedly involve issues related to cabinet functioning, organizational appointments, coordination between party and government, and the distribution of responsibilities among senior

Pakistan Launches Fresh Airstrikes Inside Afghanistan; 26 Killed Including 11 Children as Taliban Vows Retaliation

New Delhi, 10 June : A fresh wave of cross-border tensions has erupted between Pakistan and Afghanistan after Pakistani military aircraft reportedly carried out airstrikes inside Afghan territory, resulting in the deaths of at least 26 people, including 11 children. The incident has sparked widespread condemnation and heightened fears of a broader regional confrontation, with the Taliban-led Afghan administration warning that it will respond to what it described as a violation of the country's sovereignty. According to local reports from the affected areas near the Afghanistan-Pakistan border, the strikes targeted locations believed by Pakistani authorities to be hideouts of militant groups allegedly responsible for attacks across the frontier. However, residents and local officials claimed that several residential compounds were struck during the operation, leading to significant civilian casualties. Emergency re-

Bengal Cabinet Reshuffle Unveiled: Swapan Dasgupta Takes Charge as Finance Minister, Nishith Assigned New Portfolio

Kolkata, 10 June : In a significant political development, the West Bengal government has announced a major reshuffle of its Council of Ministers, introducing a series of key changes aimed at strengthening governance and accelerating policy implementation. The most notable decision is the appointment of Swapan Dasgupta as the state's new Finance Minister, a move that is expected to shape the government's economic agenda in the coming years. The cabinet reorganization also includes a change in responsibilities for Nishith, who has been assigned a new departmental portfolio as part of the broader administrative restructuring. The reshuffle is being viewed as an effort to bring renewed focus and efficiency to governance while aligning ministerial responsibilities with evolving policy priorities.
